Founded in memory of Katie Nicole Key, the Katie Key Outreach Project brings dating violence awareness to students ages 11 through 18.

Katie Nicole Key, an outgoing and bright student of West Greene High School in Greene County Tennessee fell victim to dating violence and lost her life in a tragic murder/suicide in 2007.

Founded in 2008, the Katie Key Outreach project:

- Bring awareness of dating violence to students ages 11 through 18.
- Expose warning signs and behaviors that could lead to dating violence.
- Provide participants with emotional support.
- Provide access to counseling services.

A Safe Harbor Home, Inc. was founded in 2008 as a 501(c) 3 organization.
